



Understanding our part numbers

Here at CargoGlide, we can customize our sliding bed trays to fit nearly any application.

Our part numbers, in a sense, give a description of each specific unit.

The size typically indicates outside length (75") by inside deck width (48").

The standard extruded side rails add an additional 1 ¼" to the total width of the CargoGlide sliding bed tray.

(Unless otherwise indicated by the "MO" extension.)

The weight capacity in pounds is the first number indicated.

Example:

CG1000XL-7548-MO

CG is the prefix for all CargoGlide sliding bed tray units and accessories.

Optional XL units have 100% extension.

They are available in 1000 lb, 1500 lb and 2200 lb capacities.

The optional MO ("Maximum Outside") extension is needed for any unit where the thickness of the side rails is included in the width dimensions.

The optional LP ("Low Profile") extension can also be added to the end of CG1500XL and CG2200XL part numbers. This indicates the lowering of the deck surface and tailgate clearance by one inch.

This indicates the maximum outside width as opposed to the interior deck width.
